During this coming time of Lent let us try to take time in our busy lives to spiritually renew ourselves as we prepare for Easter. The word Lent (or Lenten) is derived from the Old English lencten, which means, "spring" a time associated with new life and renewal. Just as in nature, the transformation from winter to spring is not instantaneous, so our conversion and growth in the life of Christ requires work and time. This coming week we begin Lent with our Ash Wednesday mass at 7:00 p.m. and on Friday at 6:00 p.m. is a simple Lenten supper with Stations of the Cross to follow at 7:00 p.m. It would be great to see some of you come for the supper and stations.

After the lull—the whirlwind

Things looked quiet on site for the first two weeks of February. The painters were followed by the floor grinder/ polisher, and during those times no one else could work inside. Outdoors, the landscapers began installing the topsoil. This week the interior is abuzz with activity. The whole nave and hall floor area is covered with the cedar which is being first-coated with the clear finish for the interior wood, while the finished boards are being installed in the sanctuary: 20 foot high clear cedar 1X4. When that's done the exterior boards

will be first and second-coated, then installed. The bathroom cabinets and fixtures are being installed, the sacristy cabinets are in, multi-purpose room storage cabinets go in next. The kitchen range hood is in, and the heating and ventilation units are being installed: carried up the nifty extension stairladder that drops down from the mechanical room entry.

Outside, the prefinished Hardi-panels are being applied, the extension to the overhang above the main entry is being finished, and the irrigation system pipes are laid in the rain gardens, the lawn area, and the long buffer strip north of the parking lot. Meanwhile off-site, the landscapers are mixing the topsoil to the proper specifications: mainly by adding sand and compost as they screen the soil. The clear cedar decking will soon be delivered and installed.

The Worship and Decor Advisory Committee has decided on the chairs, and their recommendation has been approved, the order placed. See pictures and details on the bulletin board downstairs. Likewise for the dividers. Since the dividers are a unique design, we have only approximations of what they will look like: a model from our Architect, who designed them, felt samples to show the colour scheme, and photos of an actual frame.
